We moved to Wright Patterson due to my wife Karen's medical challenges. The moment I contacted the PWF, I received excellent care. With the wife being in a wheelchair and the house not being handicap equipped, you all asked what you could do to be of assistance.

A new handicap shower was installed, smaller toilet to fit the small bathroom, lower, smaller sink and the entrance into the bathroom was widened. I keep saying smaller because the bathroom is small and not meant for handicapped but you all made adjustments which allowed Karen to use the bathroom. The shower is great! Small ramp allows the wheelchair to roll right up and the pull down shower seat makes her independent.

In addition, a ramp was placed at the front entrance for ease into the house. And the small bit of concrete you poured created a larger area out front for Karen to wheel up to the house. The back porch was replaced with the concrete up to the doorway (step removed) and a small ramp installed allowing her to actually use the back porch.

You did offer to install hand rails in the hallway but we didn't think it was necessary.
